

Directions to Tollhaven Learning Centre:

From NORTH/WEST London:

Come west on Commissioners Rd to Gideon Drive (there's a sign for Circle R horse ranch). Turn left on Gideon. Following Gideon to Carriage Rd (there's a sign for Circle R horse ranch). Turn left on Carriage Rd. Follow Carriage Rd south over Hwy 2, over Hwy 402, past Westminster Rd. You will pass a big yellow farmhouse on your right, we are the next place on the left.

From SOUTH London:

Come west on Hwy #2 thru Lambeth. First major road west of Lambeth is Murray Rd. Turn left on Murray Rd....take the right of the "Y" which turns into Sharon Rd. The first stop sign is Carriage Rd. Turn left onto Carriage Rd. Follow Carriage Rd south past Westminster Rd. You will pass a big yellow farmhouse on your right, we are the next place on the left.

From EAST London/401/TORONTO:

Either come across the city to link up to one of the above or TAKE THE 401 westbound to HWY #4 NORTH. Hwy #4 is the next exit PAST the 402.

TAKE THE 401 westbound to HWY #4 NORTH. Hwy #4 is the next exit PAST the 402. Follow the off ramp to the first traffic light. Go straight thru this intersection onto Littlewoods Rd. Follow Littlewoods Rd to the first stop sign which is Carriage Rd. Turn right on Carriage Rd. We are about 1.5 miles up on your right.

From EASTBOUND HWY #401

Although there is a 'backway' from Union Rd, it is quicker and simpler to come down to the exit of Hwy#4 North. This exit will wrap around and take you over the bridge over the 401, as you leave the bridge you will see a Left Turn lane appear. This is Littlewoods Rd. Turn left onto Littlewoods and continue to the first stop sign which is Carriage Rd. Turn right on Carriage Rd and we are about 1.5 miles up on your right.

There will be no food vendor on site, closest restaurants are 15 min. away in Lambeth, Delaware or London.

Entry Procedures:

No hand deliveries. No more than 2 Households per envelope. No deliveries requiring a signature.

Notice to Competitors:

These trials will run rain or shine. Please bring necessary protection for you and your dog.

All dogs must have a valid AAC Dog Identification Card in order to compete. An application is included in the rear of this premium. Dogs cannot compete if they have not been issued a card.

Obstacles will be chosen from the list of current AAC approved obstacles.

This test is being held under the Agility Association of Canada Inc. (AAC) Rules. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of the AAC Rules and Regulations, to include but not limited to the following:

- This test is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression towards people or other dogs.
- No leads, collars, food or toys or other training aids/devices shall be permitted on the course at any time (this includes in your pockets).
- There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event the dog is absent on the day of the trial, EXCEPT FOR BITCHES IN SEASON OR INJURED DOGS, and/or if the dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Any handler who is found to abuse a dog will be disqualified. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open, or be completed, by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, acts of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- There will be a \$5 Admin fee applied to refunded entry fees, regardless of when the entry is withdrawn.
- All competitors participate in the events at their own risk. The General Agreement on the back of the entry form must be signed in order to comply with AAC's acceptance.

This trial will be held outdoors at Tollhaven Learning Centre. Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in action and conduct by handlers at all times. All dogs MUST BE ON LEASH at all times unless competing in the ring or using warm up equipment. This will be strictly enforced as our property is close to the road. Exhibitors are advised that the agility field is aerated twice a year and, while every effort is made to time this maintenance so as to have the least impact on our trials, adverse weather and soil conditions may cause delays in scheduling which move the aerating closer to event dates. The main noticeable affect of aeration is the abundance of small plugs of soil laying atop the grass, until the plugs break down and dissolve back into the turf. These earth plugs pose no physical risk to the dogs, some dogs do experience a visual distraction upon first noticing the plugs. As per above, competitors participate at their own risk and no refunds shall be offered after the closing date.

There will be no equipment familiarization on the day of the test. A warm-up area with a single jump will be provided. No other equipment or training device will be

allowed to be utilized on the show grounds the day of the trial.

You must clean up after your dog and yourselves. There will be plenty of refuse containers and bags available. Anyone found not cleaning up after their dog, will be refused future entry.

A Maximum Course Time (MCT) and/or fault limit may be applied, depending on entry numbers. With the cooperation of exhibitors, by being ready at ring side, this will not always be necessary.

Class Descriptions:

AAC Starters Class: The starters class shall be for dogs not having earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title. A dog must achieve 3 clear rounds under 2 different judges to be awarded the ADC title.

AAC Advanced Class: The advanced class shall be for dogs having earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title, but that have not earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada (AADC). A dog must achieve 3 clear rounds under 2 different judges to be awarded the AADC title.

AAC Masters Class: The master class shall be for dogs having earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada (AADC) title. To be awarded the Master Agility Dog of Canada title by the AAC, a dog must achieve 3 clear Master rounds under 2 different judges, and earn qualifying scores in all 4 Games at the Advanced level to be awarded the MADC title.

AAC Veteran Class: Veteran class is for dogs 7 years of age and older or dogs 5 years of age and older who have been competing in the Special Agility class for a minimum of 1 year.

AAC Special Class: Special class is open to all dogs. A dog entered in Special Classes may move to the Veteran Classes. A dog may no longer compete in the regular class once entered at an official trial in any of the Veteran or Special agility classes. Dogs moving into Veterans & Specials from regular classes take their qualifying legs with them (they move laterally)

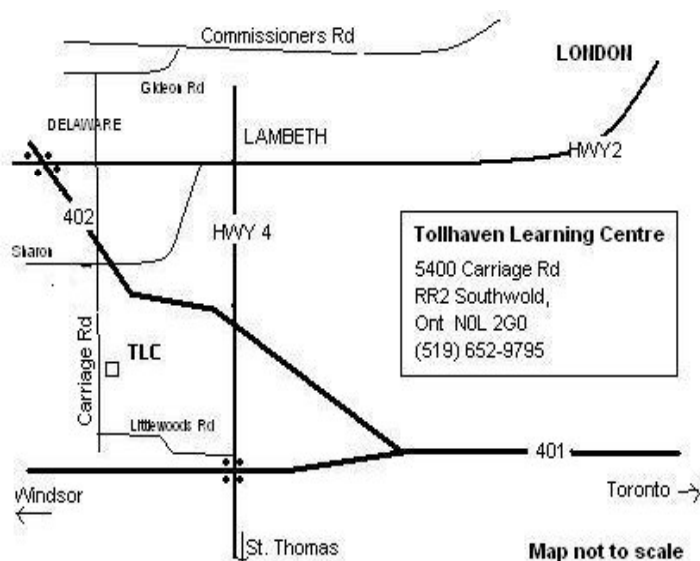
Prizes and Awards:

In each of the Standard and Games rounds, ribbons will be awarded 1st to 4th in the Mini and Open divisions. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs who achieve a qualifying score in any class.

On Site Facilities:

Located on just under 2 acres, Tollhaven Learning Centre is our home and a dream come true. We ask that you respect the chain-link back yard as our dog's private area and utilize the other areas of our property to exercise your dogs. Our fully fenced agility field measures 200' X 100', of which the competition ring will be 120'X100'. The remainder of the fenced area will provide about 80' of ring edge for tenting/crating and exercise/warmup area. This area for tenting etc has no trees. There are trees on our front yard that you are welcome to utilize for shade, but unfortunately there is no view to the ring from them. The small barn located within the fenced ring will provide covered crating for approximately 15 crates on a first come, first served basis. Quiet dogs only in the barn, please. You may also use the classroom for quiet dogs, and there is a microwave there that you may use.

In moderate to dry weather, we have plenty of parking on our front lawn, altho you cannot see the complete ring area from there. Parking in very muddy, wet conditions could be a challenge. Space on the actual driveway is limited, so if it's been raining heavily, please come ready to be cosy with your 'neighbours' and please, work with our "Parking Attendent" when you arrive to help us create safe parking for everyone. Last year we had no problems at all, and thank you to our 'regulars' who know just how to maximize the parking spaces!



There will be the usual royal blue porta-potty, as well as plastic swimming pools for the dogs to cool off in. We can provide a hose for those who wish, but we suggest you bring drinking water for your dogs as our water has a fair amount of sulphur.
